How Local Election Officials Can Prepare for the Risks of Al

This language capability concerns Noah Praetz, who managed one of the country's largest election districts before founding <u>The Elections Group</u>. The Voting Rights Act <u>requires</u> language assistance during elections to some minority groups if their numbers are big enough in a community, but that doesn't mean election officials have the capacity or manpower to monitor or respond to misinformation in every language spoken in their communities. (All told, Americans speak <u>more than 350</u> languages.)

"There are communication pockets within the United States that aren't particularly accessible to election officials to combat anything that might be false," Praetz says.
